#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2498**

#### **AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT WITH THE THIBODAUX CITY MARSHAL (DEPUTY CITY MARSHAL)**

***BE IT ORDAINED* by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:**

***WHEREAS*, the City and City Marshal are desirous of entering into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement in order to identify the responsibilities of each of the parties to accommodate the appointment of a Chief Deputy City Marshal; and**

***WHEREAS*, the City Marshal will provide the funding for the Chief Deputy City Marshal to include the salary, fringe benefits, worker's compensation, all insurance coverage, retirement, operating supplies, vehicle and vehicle expenses including maintenance, fuel, insurance, etc. and any and all other expenses associated with the position; and**

***WHEREAS*, the City shall fix the salary of the Chief Deputy City Marshal, process payments to the Chief Deputy City Marshal through the City's payroll system, and shall invoice the City Marshal monthly for expenses incurred through the position of Chief Deputy City Marshal; and**

***WHEREAS*, in order for the City to accept the City Marshal's funds for the Chief Deputy City Marshal position it is necessary to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement with the City Marshal outlining the terms and purpose of the cooperative effort between the two governmental agencies; and**

**WHEREAS**, in order for the City to execute this proposed agreement it is necessary for the Council to authorize the Mayor to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Thibodaux City Marshal under the conditions mentioned hereinabove relative to the position of Chief Deputy City Marshal.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that a copy of the said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby made a part hereof.
