

ORDINANCE NO. ____

ORDINANCE WHICH SETS FORTH THE GENERAL ALIMONY, STREETS, ROADS & ALLEYS, AND FIRE DEPARTMENT "ADJUSTED" MILLAGE RATES AND ROLL FORWARD TO MILLAGE RATES NOT EXCEEDING THE "MAXIMUM" AUTHORIZED RATES; AND ADOPTS THE 2018 LEVY RATE FOR THE FIRE PROTECTION FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF THIBODAUX FOR 2018 TAX YEAR

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Thibodaux the Parish of Lafourche, Louisiana, in a public meeting held on July 17, 2018, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B), that the taxing district voted to increase the millage rate(s), but not in excess of the prior year's maximum rate(s), on all taxable property shown on the official assessment roll for the year 2018, and when collected, the revenues from said taxes shall be used only for the specific purposes for which said taxes have been levied. Said millage rate(s) are:

General Alimony (5066 001):	4.630 mills	5.020 mills
Streets, Roads, & Alleys (5066 002):	2.530 mills	2.740 mills
Fire Department (5066 003):	1.690 mills	1.830 mills

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Assessor of the Parish of Lafourche, shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2018 the taxes herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with law.

The foregoing ordinance was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the ordinance was adopted by no less than two-thirds of the total membership of the taxing authority voting in favor as required by Article VII, Section 23(C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B).
