**Mayor Charles Caillouet Announces Summer Employment Available for
Area Youth (16 and older) Seeking Employment with the

Thibodaux, LA – Mayor Charles Caillouet announces, “There are additional positions available for area youth, ages 16 and up, seeking summer employment with the City of Thibodaux.” The positions include: Lifeguards, TREC Youth Camp Counselors, Baseball Umpires, Baseball Scorekeepers and workers for the new Tennis program. Applications are currently being accepted at Thibodaux Recreation Department, 151 Peltier Drive.

Youth Counselors will work at the City’s Summer Youth Camp for boys and girls ages 5-12, which will be housed at Warren J.
