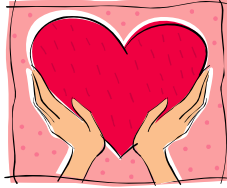

HELP YOUR NEIGHBOR PROGRAM

A Utility Assistance Program for Eligible Senior Citizens and Disabled Citizens

The “Help Your Neighbor” Program was developed by the City of Thibodaux in an effort to assist senior citizens and disabled persons living on fixed incomes pay their **WATER, SEWER, GAS, and GARBAGE** bills. To qualify for the program, applicants must:

- * Reside within the corporate city limits of Thibodaux and be at least 60 years old or disabled/handicapped
- * The individual or household income shall not exceed the current U. S. Poverty Income Guidelines
- * Complete an application through the Lafourche Council on Aging

Qualified individuals and/or households may receive two payments of up to **\$50.00** each per year to pay for city utilities.
