Acadia Pedestrian Walkway Enhancement Project



The Project is Underway!

Located in front of Thibodaux Regional Medical Center, Phase I of the Acadia Pedestrian Walkway Enhancement (APWE) Project stretches down the abandoned railroad corridor from Audubon Avenue to the Percy Brown Road. Construction of the 6 foot, concrete, lighted walkway will not only aesthetically enhance the developing area near the hospital, but will create a safe pedestrian walkway and bicycle path for residents.

Byron Talbot Contractors are handling the project. Phase I of the APWE will be completed in approximately 5 weeks. Following construction, the city's Parks Department will landscape the area.

The project is being funded with federal ARRA funds and costs approximately \$205,000.

When additional funds are available, Phase II of the APWE Project will continue the walkway from Audubon Avenue to Bayou Lane and connect to the walking path on the Nicholls State University campus.
