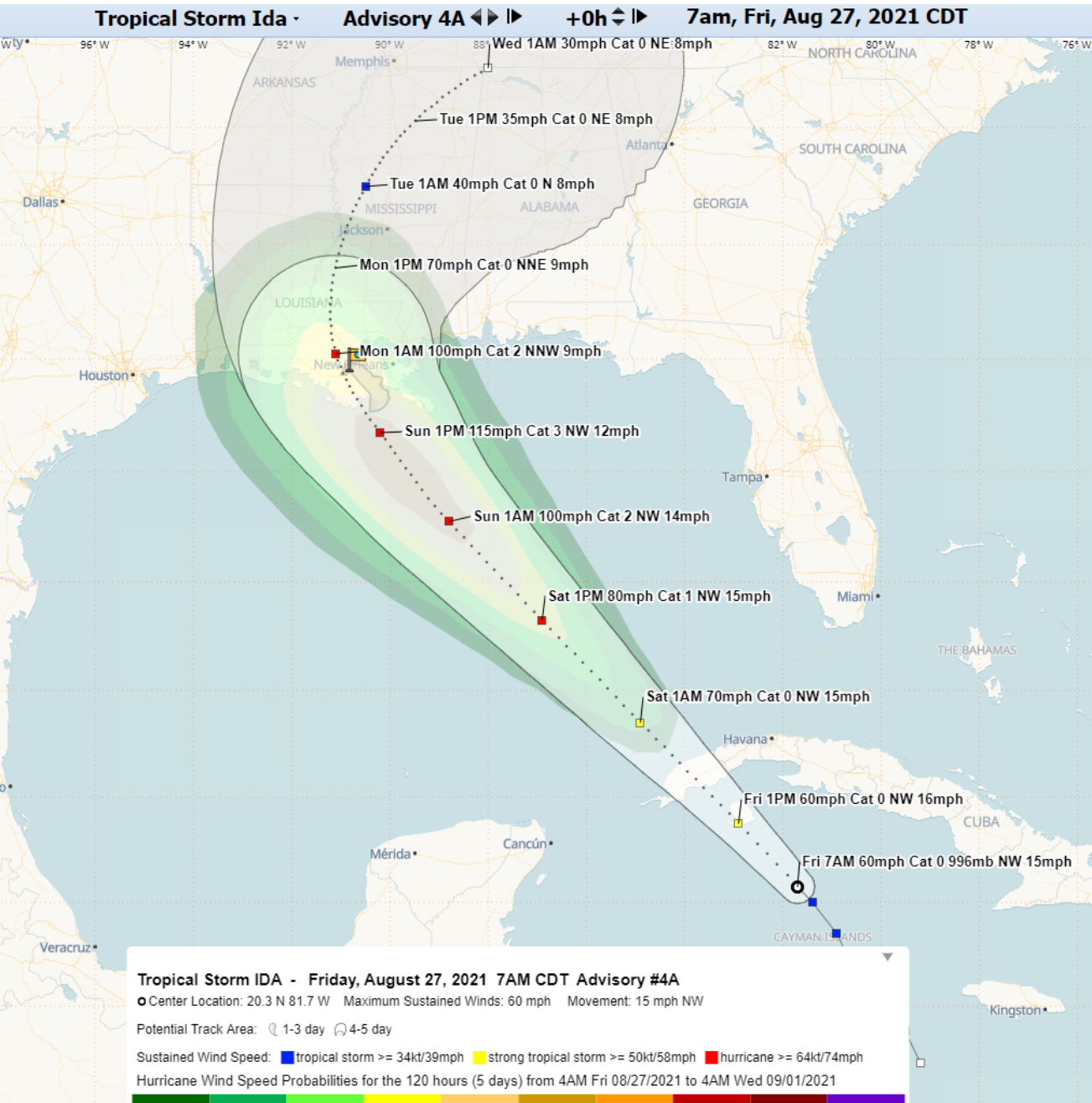

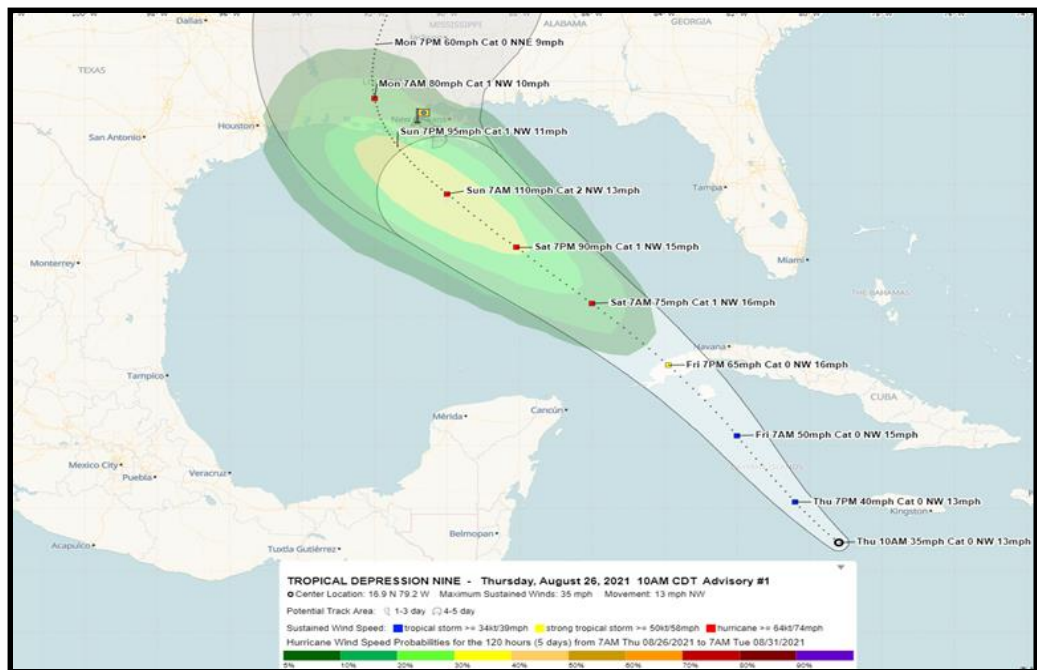
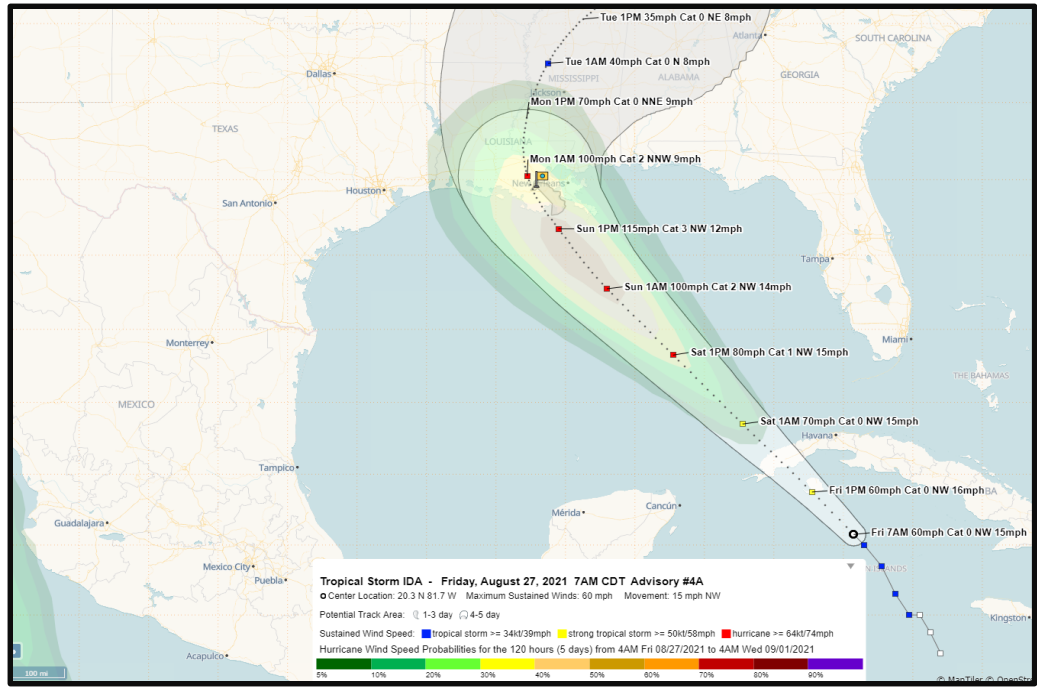
# Weather Update

# Mayor's Critical Information Requirements

1. Any Tropical Depression or Storm that enters or develops in the Caribbean Sea, the Southern Atlantic Ocean, or the Gulf of Mexico **August 26, 2021**
2. Significant changes in Storm intensity & projected H-Hour (*Tropical Storm winds on Louisiana coast*) Tropical storm winds along the Louisiana coast projected **August 26, 2021**
3. Regional Parish, State & Federal Declarations of Emergency in Louisiana or any adjacent Gulf Coast State
  - Governor declared a state of emergency on **August 26, 2021**
  - Lafourche Parish declared a state of emergency on **August 27, 2021**
  - Federal Presidential Pre-Land Fall Declaration requested on **XXX**
4. Any loss or significant degradation of any communication system used by Emergency Management Officials **None**
5. Any evacuation orders by Local Officials **Lafourche/Terrebonne/St. Mary**
6. Any major issues raised by Parish Presidents or Mayors in potential effected areas **Storm Effects in All Bayou/River Parishes**
7. Any changes to the manning level of the State EOC State EOC **24/7 on August 27, 2021**

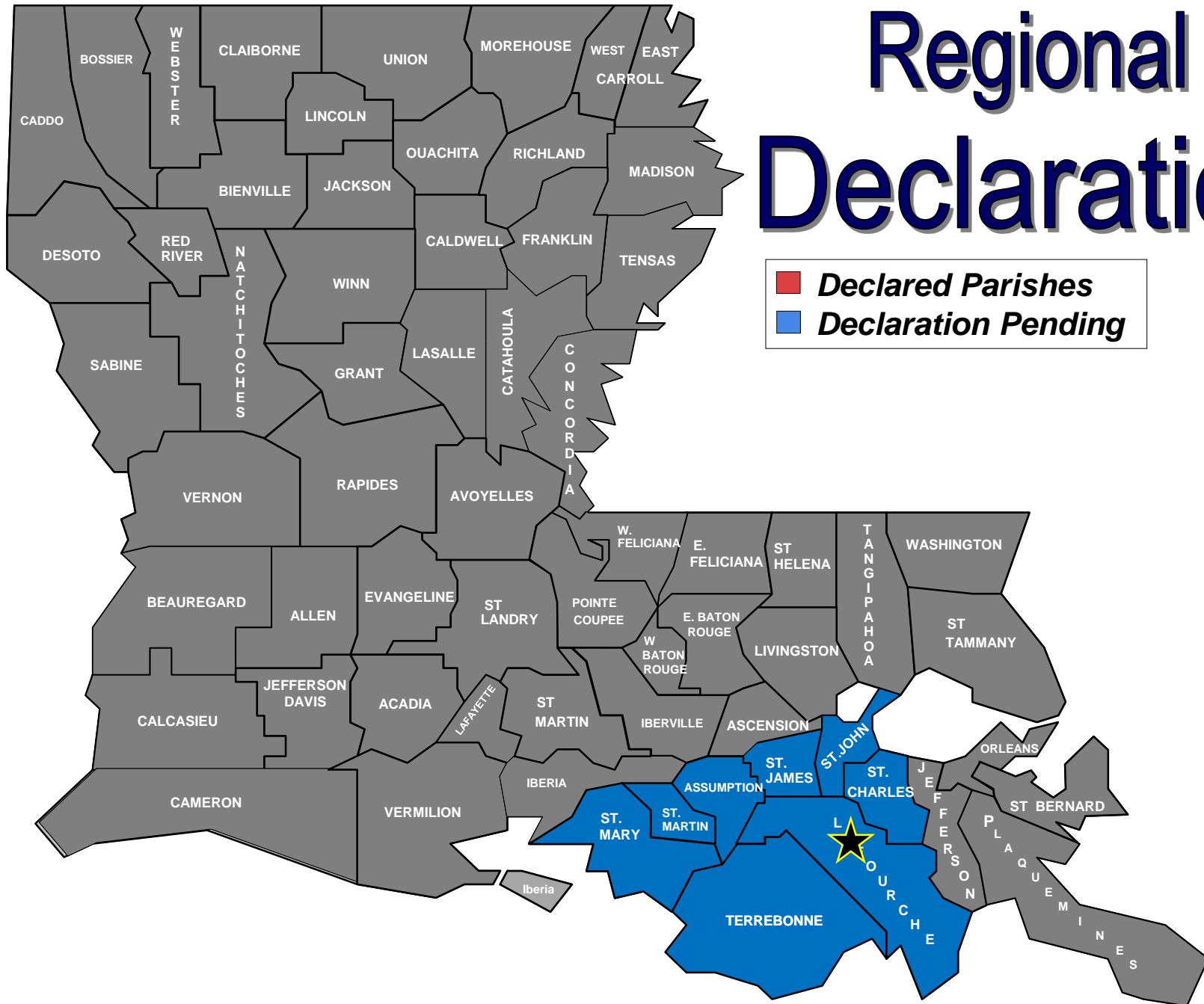
# Situational Summary- Friday August 27, 2021

- 1. The City of Thibodaux (COT) has monitored this event for the past 48 hours (H-96 to H-48) and the Mayor activated the unified command group at H-72 (August 26, 2021 2:00pm)**
- 2. COT issued a PSA at H-72 (August 26, 2021 3:00pm), conducted a radio call in today and will issue another PSA today after the conference call cycle this am**
- 3. COT Public Works has cleaned catch basins, filled all the generator tanks, cycling the water in the reservoir/towers, is closing the storm shutters on all buildings and will have a self fill sand bag location at the barn starting today**
- 4. COT Parks and Recreation swept the city for loose trash pickup as well as emptying trash cans**
- 5. TPD has alerted essential personnel and is prepared to respond as needed**
- 6. TVFD has tested emergency equipment, alerted personnel and is prepared to respond as needed**
- 7. Non-essential COT employees will be sent home at Noon today**

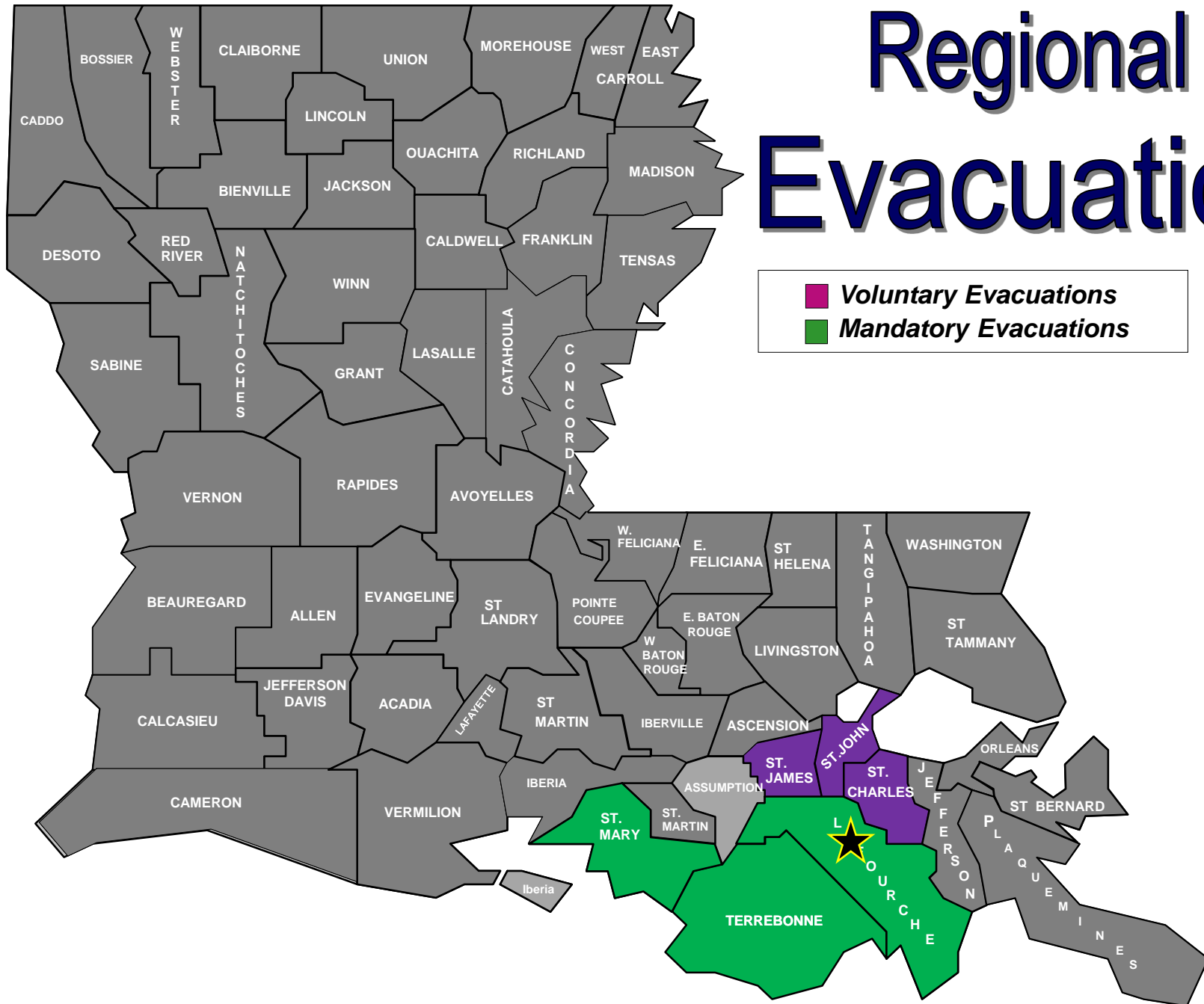
# Lafourche Parish Situation

- 1. Lafourche Parish Declaration on August 27, 2021**
- 2. EOC Operations will go to full staffing today**
- 3. Issuing mandatory evacuations outside of the flood gates and voluntary evacuations for all of Lafourche Parish today. On August 28, 2021 there will be a mandatory evacuation for all parish residents in mobile homes and trailers**
- 4. Sandbag operations will open today**
- 5. Shelter operations will open on Saturday, August 28, 2021**

# COT Incident Action Plan- Next 24 Hours

1. COT will continue to monitor the event and make a decisions through the COT's Unified Command Group (UCG).
2. COT preparations will continue through H-hour with essential personnel on standby through this weekend.
3. COT will issue a PSA after the series of conference calls today, August 27, 2021.
4. A curfew is being be reviewed to be put in place Saturday night. The Mayor will make a decision and put it out as part of the PSA on Saturday.
