The Project Engineer, David Waitz, has submitted Change Order No. 4 for the Replacement of the Ultraviolet Light System at the Thibodaux Wastewater Treatment Plant to the City for approval.

This change order is being proposed in order to remove the motorized monorails line item from the contract, and to include 261 additional contract days due to supply chain delays experienced from COVID 19. The proposed change order decreases the contract price by \$48,900.00 thereby making the total contract price \$520,705.76.

David Waitz, 1107 Canal Boulevard, spoke about the change order and substantial completion and answered questions from the Council.
