The Mayor has requested that Fairway Consulting and Engineering prepare an agreement that would authorize the firm to coordinate and manage the drainage investigation work, to be performed as part of our Master Services Agreement with Compliance Enviro Systems, in the Old Rienzi/Rienzi Manor area.

The proposed agreement stipulates that Fairway will perform the duties associated with the aforesaid project in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00.

On motion of Councilman Taylor, seconded by Councilwoman Crochet, the Council voted on a resolution to authorize the Mayor to sign an Engineering Contract with Fairway Consulting and Engineering for the Old Rienzi/Rienzi Manor Drainage Investigation. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

## ORDINANCE NO. 3391

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN ENTITY/STATE AGREEMENT WITH THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT FOR THE CITY OF THIBODAUX CANAL BOULEVARD AND 5<sup>TH</sup> STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded funds appropriated out of the Federal Highway Administration to finance improvement projects under the direct administration of LA DOTD; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested an appropriation of funds to finance a portion of the City of Thibodaux Canal Boulevard and 5<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvement Project as described herein and DOTD is agreeable to the implementation of the Project and desires to cooperate with the Entity as hereinafter provided; and

WHEREAS, in order to proceed with this Project with the State it is necessary to execute an Entity/State Agreement with the DOTD outlining the terms and purpose of the cooperative effort between the two public agencies for State Project No. H.015371; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to execute this proposed agreement it is necessary for the Council to authorize the Mayor to do so.

*NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED* by the City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an Entity/State Agreement with the State of Louisiana DOTD under the conditions mentioned hereinabove.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of the said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby made a part hereof.
