The City Council of the City of Thibodaux assembled in regular session at its regular meeting place, City Hall, 310 West 2^{nd} Street, Thibodaux, Louisiana, on Tuesday, September 2, 2025 at 5:00 P.M.

A moment of silence was observed in honor of City Councilman Gene Richard who passed away on August 21, 2025.

The Mayor made a presentation on the results of the Rienzi Subdivision drainage study conducted by Fairway Consulting and Engineering, and gave updates of the status of the work being done in that area based on those results.

The Public Works Director has notified the Council Administrator that the contractor, Southern Coatings, LLC, has submitted Change Order No. 1 and 2 for the Canal Blvd/Candy Lane Water tower Painting Project to the City for approval.

Change Order No. 1 is being proposed in order to make repairs to the valve pit at the Candy Lane tank site, and increases the contract amount by \$3,148.00. Change Order No. 2 is proposed in order to stabilize the overflow pipe, install a new ladder locking gate, and repair the bowl ladder on the Candy Lane tower, and increases the contract price by \$16,018.00 thereby making the total contract amount \$739,766.00.

The Public Works Director has informed the Council Administrator that the City has requested that Leonard Chauvin Engineering prepare an engineering contract for your consideration which would authorize the design of the 2025 Road Improvement Project which includes St. Joseph Street, Tetreau Street from Menard to 12th Street, Tetreau Street from 12th Street to Gerald T. Peltier, and Iris Street.

In accordance with the provisions of the proposed contract, the City would pay basic engineering fees as a percentage of construction cost, which is estimated at \$671,237.00, in accordance with Exhibit D of the contract. The basic service fee is estimated to be \$54,370.00, and additional fees for topographic surveys in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00, and construction observation in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.

The State Department of Transportation and Development, Division of Aviation administers a Grant Program to partially fund improvements to local eligible airport facilities. The Mayor is interested in applying for grant funds under the provisions of this program.

The purpose of the grant application is to acquire funding to make improvements to the Thibodaux Municipal Airport. The total estimated cost of the proposed FY 2026-2030 improvements to the airport is \$4,636,370.00.

On motion of Councilwoman Crochet, seconded by Councilman Taylor, the Council voted on a resolution authorizing the Mayor to submit a Capital Improvement Plan approved by the FAA and DOTD to the State of Louisiana which outlines the specific future development of the Thibodaux Municipal Airport. The City executed an engineering contract with DDG for the Land and Water Conservation Fund Project-Miracle League Baseball Field Project on February 24, 2023. In order for DDG to include construction observation services, and material testing through South Louisiana Testing; and to remove structural engineer review and design fees, it is necessary to amend the agreement in order to include additional fees. Amendment #1 increases the Professional Services Agreement total by \$19,500.00, making the total cost for engineering services for this project \$97,273.50.

Due to the untimely death of Councilman Gene Richard, the provisions of Article III, Section 11 (B) of the City Charter requires the Council to call a special election to fill the unexpired term exceeding one year within ten days of the date that the vacancy occurs.

The Council Administrator has notified the Secretary of State's office of the vacancy, and they have provided the information on the next available election that we will be able to call the special election to fill the vacancy. The qualifying dates will be January 14, 15, and 16, 2026, with the primary election on April 18, 2026, and if necessary, the general election date is May 30, 2026.

Councilman Taylor introduced an ordinance to amend and re-enact Section 21-43 of the Thibodaux City Code of Ordinances – Water Rates.

Councilwoman Crochet introduced an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement with the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development for improvements at the Thibodaux Municipal Airport – GA Maintenance 2025.

The Public Hearing on these ordinances will be held at the Council meeting on September 16, 2025.

The Mayor's Office has informed the Council Administrator that the Lafourche Parish Government wishes to enter into a cooperative endeavor with the City in order for them to provide funding to the City from the State of Louisiana's Parish Transportation Revenue Program. The Parish will remit monthly payments in the amount of 16.35% of the amount paid directly to the Parish by the Louisiana Department of Treasury for the State's 2025-2026 fiscal year.

The agreement stipulates that the funds provided by Lafourche Parish from this program must be used to assist with the City's road systems maintenance costs.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT WITH THE LAFOURCHE PARISH GOVERNMENT FOR THE 2025-2026 TRANSPORTATION REVENUE PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, the City of Thibodaux and Lafourche Parish are desirous of entering into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement in order to provide funding from the State of Louisiana's Parish Transportation Revenue Program Funding to offset the City's roads systems maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, the Parish receives funding from the State for the 2025-2026 fiscal year for road systems maintenance costs pursuant to LA R.S. 48:751-756; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement the Parish of Lafourche wishes to remit monthly payments to the City in the amount of 16.35% of the amount paid directly to Lafourche Parish Government by the Louisiana Department of Treasury for the State of Louisiana's 2025-2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to accept the aforesaid funds it is necessary for the Mayor to execute a cooperative endeavor agreement with the Lafourche Parish Government outlining the terms and purpose of the cooperative effort between the two governmental agencies; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Lafourche Parish Government for the transfer of Transportation Revenue Program Funding to the City of Thibodaux for the State of Louisiana's 2025-2026 fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of the said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby made a part hereof.
