

Title: Laborer Associate-LARC - PT

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

BRIEF DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of this position is to provide work for mentally handicapped citizens. This is accomplished by hiring these citizens to complete work such as assisting in general tasks; cleaning and painting public properties; providing maintenance functions; cleaning streets and ditches; picking up litter; performing basic landscaping duties; and maintaining public parks. Other duties include cleaning and maintaining equipment and performing other duties as assigned.
