

RESOLUTION NO. 755

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled that:

Whereas, IT IS THE DESIRE OF THE City Council to require all men between the ages of 18 and 26 applying for employment with the City of Thibodaux to submit evidence of registration with the Selective Service System as a condition of employment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux, Louisiana:

SECTION 1: That the City Council does hereby approve the following language on employment requirements and authorizes the language to be incorporated into the City's Personnel Policies and Procedures to be effective July 18, 2000.

Every male who is at least 18 years old, but has not yet attained the age of 26 seeking employment with the City of Thibodaux shall submit documentation evidencing his registration or exception from registration with the Federal Selective Service System before being employed.

SECTION 2: That this policy shall become effective July 18, 2000.
